

Building Code Recognition

Structural fiberboard has been recognized in the model building codes as an acceptable wall bracing material for many years. Its presence in the codes precludes the need for a specific evaluation report because it is certified by an ICC-ES recognized agency as meeting the code-referenced product standard.
